

TINCORN HILL QUARRY

THE DEVELOPMENT PROPOSAL

INTRODUCTION

Breedon intend to make a planning application to East Ayrshire Council for the following development;

- A Lateral extension of quarrying operations to the north and east of permitted extraction.
- Deepening of the extended quarry void.
- Restoration of the quarry excavation to a waterbody, native woodland planting and acid grassland/heath.
- This will release circa 17.8 million tonnes of saleable aggregates which would allow for a further 50 years of operations.

MINERAL EXTRACTION

The proposed extension and deepening would be operated as a continuation of the current permitted operations, using the conventional quarrying techniques currently employed at the Site.

The proposal would extend operations at current permitted depths to the north and east before deepening the quarry by a further 2 benches (or levels) below existing.

The overall proposed development would be worked over 4 phases.
